Dear Friends,

My granddaughter is learning the months of the year in Pre-K. Yesterday she was regaling me with her sing-song list of them...but she forgot October. When I pointed this out, she was aghast. In the midst of all our personal busyness and the never-ending march of national and world events, so many of which are distressing and heartbreaking, we often find ourselves overwhelmed. At those times it's easy to spiral into anguish or doomscroll till dawn. Instead, let me suggest another way of handling the bombardment: silence and prayer. A moment spent alone without external noise and with the presence of God can calm our minds and restore focus. We can remember our rightful place in creation, and let go of responsibility that does not belong to

"In a world so wired and interconnected, our anxious hearts are pummeled by an endless barrage of troubling news. We are daily aware of more grief, O Lord, than we can rightly consider, of more suffering and scandal than we can respond to, of more hostility, hatred, horror, and injustice than we can engage with compassion.

"But you, O Lord, are not disquieted by such news of cruelty and terror and war. You are neither anxious nor overwhelmed. You carried the full weight of the suffering of a broken world when you hung upon the cross, and you carry it still.

"When the cacophony of universal distress unsettles us, remind us that we are but small and finite creatures, never designed to carry the vast abstractions of great burdens, for our arms are too short and our strength is too small. Justice and mercy, healing and redemption, are your great labors.

"So give us discernment in the face of our troubles to cast the burdens of this world upon the strong shoulders of the one who alone is able to bear them up. Amen."




Backpack Feeding Program Scott's Run Wednesday, October 8th - 12:30 p.m.


